Pastor Jeff Jackson is the founder of Shepherd's Staff Mission Facilitators and is currently the Director of Church Relations and Missionary Care. As such, he trains prospective missionaries and speaks regularly at numerous missions conferences in the United States and abroad.

Along with his family, Pastor Jeff lived in the Philippines from 1987 to 1993 while planting Calvary Chapel of Cebu City. After returning from the mission field, he planted a multi-ethnic church in the San Diego area, while also teaching the missions courses at Calvary Chapel Bible College in Murrieta, CA. Before assuming his current role with Shepherd's Staff, he was the senior pastor of Cross-Connection International Fellowship in Phoenix, AZ, a church that was heavily engaged with reaching refugees that had been resettled to Phoenix from around the world.

An ardent supporter of the pro-life movement, Pastor Jeff was part of the steering committee that began the first Crisis Pregnancy Center, Alternatives, in his hometown of Escondido, CA. He has spoken at CPC fundraisers, and will soon begin serving on the board of a CPC in the San Diego area.
